

Frequently Asked Questions

for Rebuilding Together Volunteers

Q: I signed up to volunteer, may I bring a friend?

A: Yes, friends are welcome. If you wish to bring a group of 4 or more, then it is better to arrange this by phone or email ahead of time.

Q: I know the hours of the project but I may need to come late or leave early. Is that OK?

A: Rebuilding Together understands that volunteers have other commitments and family responsibilities.

Q: I am not familiar with that neighborhood , what if I get lost?

A: If you are lost call Michelle Kaitchuck's cell phone [765-748-4922] for directions. Also, to be sure that you have arrived at the correct location, look for the van with the Rebuilding Together sign.

Q: Do I need to bring my own tools?

A: If you have your favorite tools, you may bring them. However Rebuilding Together has the necessary tools and safety equipment, for example, work gloves and dust masks.

Q: I do not have construction skills. How can I help?

A: On a construction project we also need unskilled people who are interested in helping. They can carry boards, help measure and keep the work area clean. Rebuilding Together also needs help with office work, recruiting, fund raising and grant writing. We appreciate the advice of professionals in education or business.
